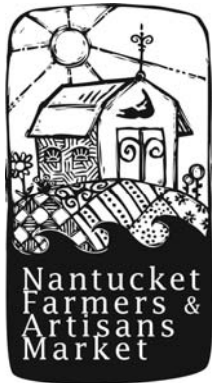

The Nantucket Farmers & Artisans Market (NFAM)

Will have two locations for the 2008 season!

Market Overview:

- The market will run for 16 weeks from June 28th through October 11th and will be held on Saturday mornings from 9:00am – 12:00pm.
- The Nantucket New School, at 15 Nobadeer Farm Road has again generously offered NFAM the use of their parking lot for the Market. There are some dates that the NNS lot is occupied for previously scheduled events, so, the market will be held at an alternate spot for six weeks – LOCATION TO BE ANNOUNCED SOON!
- The market will be held at the alternate location- TO BE ANNOUNCED for six weeks from June 28 – August 2.
- For 10 weeks from August 9 – October 11, the market will be held at the Nantucket New School.
- It is the goal of the NFAM Committee to feature 50% growers and 50% artisans at each market. To accomplish this, the NFAM Committee will review applications and confirm schedule in advance in an effort to ensure a variety of items are represented each Saturday.

To participate as a vendor:

1. Please read the 2008 NFAM Handbook thoroughly.
2. Fill out & mail your application with Annual Fee check to NFAM, PO Box 1244, Nantucket, MA 02554 – Deadline is MAY 15th.
3. Applications received after May 15th will be reviewed on a case -by-case basis and are not guaranteed space. If received after May 15th, vendor will be required to pay a higher Annual Fee.
4. In all cases, vendor will be contacted by an NFAM Committee with a market schedule confirmation.
5. We ask that Vendors participate in the Market for a minimum of 3 times.
