### **What is the Wave of Change?**

The Wave of Change is the brainchild of Dylan Wallace, a Sustainable Nantucket Green Council volunteer who holds a degree in art education. Dylan designed the Wave to be a community art project that could bring people together and get them thinking and talking about the “sea change” that is happening world-wide as humans shift into a mode of living that takes account of the effects our choices have on the environment and thus, on ourselves. It is a large-scale sculpture of a wave created out of recycled materials, mounted on a boat trailer by Dylan and other adult volunteers from the Sustainable Nantucket Green Council, and then covered with whimsical, colorful sea creatures and environmental slogans created by the children of our community.

The Wave is designed not only to raise the awareness of the participants--across a wide age spectrum--that will be involved in its creation, but also to impact and engage additional members of the community through highly visible placement around town before and after Earth Day 2008.

### **Below are the dates and times for volunteering on Sustainable Nantucket's Wave of Change project for Earth Day.**

**Saturday, April 5<sup>th</sup> from 1 pm – 3pm** we have a “sealing party.” At Dylan's house – 30 Somerset Lane.

We will be covering the kids' creatures with non-toxic clear-coat sealant to help make them weatherproof.

**Sunday, April 13<sup>th</sup> at 2 pm** we will be hanging some of those creatures up downtown on the lampposts around town.

**Between, April 13<sup>th</sup> and April 20<sup>th</sup>** – we need volunteers to check on the creatures to make sure they are holding up in the outdoor weather.

**Sunday, April 20<sup>th</sup> – at 11 am** – we need volunteers out at Bartlett's Farm to help us put up the Wave and cover it with creatures.

**April 20<sup>th</sup> at 4 pm** – we need volunteers to help us take down the Wave and take down the creatures from the lampposts downtown.
